New Six (6) Weeks Session

The last day to add and/or drop is May 23, 2014.

Students who officially withdraw, are suspended, or are expelled after add and/or drop are subject to the return of Title IV and other financial aid return of funds requirements according to published refund policies.

Students must register for a minimum of six (6) credit hours to be eligible for financial aid.

Students with delinquent accounts will not be allowed to register. Payment in full is required at the time of registration. No deferred payment plans are available.

Bookstore Purchases

- No book allowance or campus store vouchers are available for summer school.
Bookstore purchases may be made by cash, check or the following credit cards: MasterCard, Visa or American Express.

Other Expenses

- Incidental charges to a student's account must be paid immediately.
Student Summer Parking Decals are \$15.00 and are required to park on campus beginning May 26, 2014.
Room charges are non-refundable. Students who register boarding and subsequently change to non-boarding will receive an adjustment for unused board only. Board charges are refunded on a prorated basis.
NC State Sales Taxes on Food: The State of North Carolina recently made taxable many items that were previously excluded from sales taxes, including food sold to students at higher education institutions. These changes took effect January 1, 2014. If you register as a boarding student, your board charges (meal plan) are subject to sales taxes. You will be charged sales taxes based on the applicable NC State and Wake County tax rates, in addition to the cost of your meal plan. The tax rates are determined by the State of North Carolina. Sales taxes will be charged at the point of sale for all food purchased at the Saint Augustine's University Café and Grill.
Student Health Insurance: Full-time students are required to have health insurance. Saint Augustine's University offers student health insurance coverage with BCS Insurance Company. The annual policy period is August 1, 2013 - July 31, 2014. Periods of coverage are annual, Fall Semester One, Spring & Summer-Semesters and Summer Semester (New Summer Students Only). Each period of coverage has a Waiver and Enrollment Deadline. Eligibility requirements allow you to submit an insurance waiver which would provide information on your existing services. Students that do not produce evidence of insurance coverage by the deadline will automatically be enrolled in the University's insurance plan and the fee for the student health insurance coverage will be charged to the student's account.
